Specifications

The EnGarde™ is configured for use in constant or pulsating flows of metered materials. Outputs from two flow meters can be displayed as a separate total: A,B, A+B, and volume ratio A/B. When placed in the volume ratio mode, a predetermined A/B ratio is compared to the actual measured A/B volume ratio. The operator is alerted to an off-ratio condition via an alarm screen on the controller and a flashing red light on the status tower.

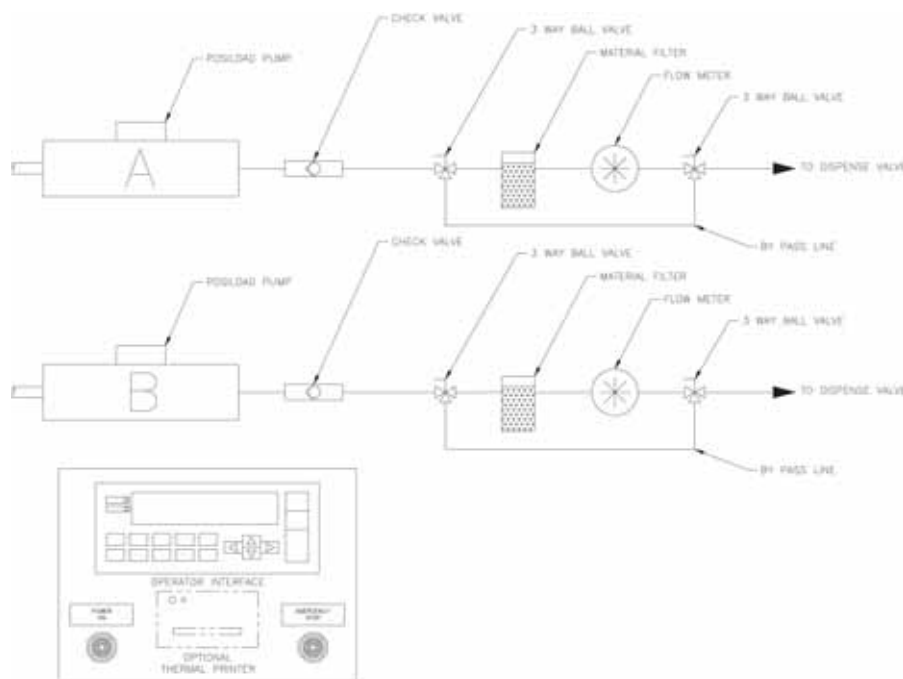
The optional printer outputs – at preset time intervals – the date, time, and ratio. The printer also records alarm messages, indicating actual off-ratio condition and ratio tolerance.

Programmable Features

- Ratio Preset: User selected, compares to actual ratio
- Ratio tolerance: User enters allowable ratio range
- Frequency of printout showing date, time, and actual ratio
